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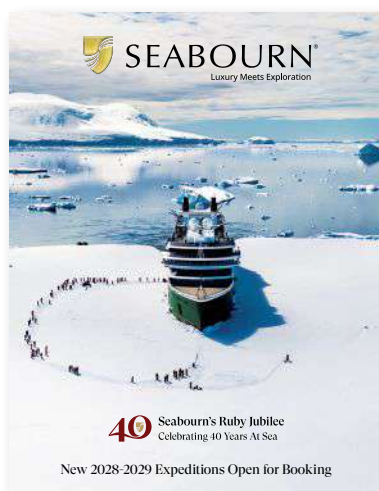

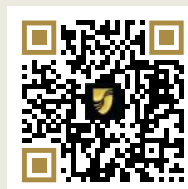

Wonder-filled moments abound — a pod of whales spotted from the deck, a walrus haulout on a rocky shore, a polar bear traversing its natural habitat. On guided walks, watch for Arctic foxes and Svalbard reindeer across the tundra.



ZODIACS & ICE CRUISING

Navigate by Zodiac® through channels dotted with icebergs and flanked by shimmering glaciers. We also dedicate at least one day to ice cruising, heading north into the pack ice to search for wildlife and take in panoramic views from our uncrowded decks.



HISTORIC REMAINS

Remnants of human settlement appear throughout Svalbard, from whaling-era cottages to trappers' huts. These austere structures, standing against some of the harshest conditions on Earth, speak to a life of extraordinary isolation and resilience.

EXPEDITION HIGHLIGHT MONUMENTAL ISLAND, NUNAVUT

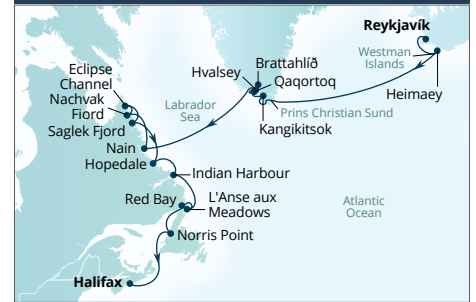

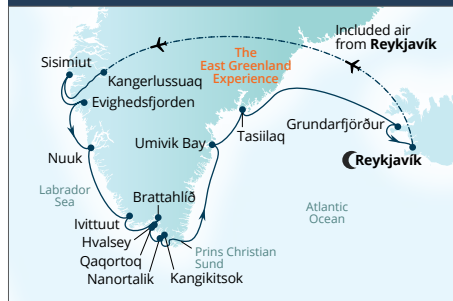

The Northwest Passage

Follow the routes of legendary Arctic expeditions into a landscape where history, wildlife, and dramatic ice-filled channels converge at every turn.



BEECHEY ISLAND

Sir John Franklin's ill-fated expedition wintered here in 1845, establishing this island as a pivotal hub for Arctic exploration. Today, historic grave markers stand against a stark backdrop of gravel ridges, vast beaches, and the occasional polar bear.



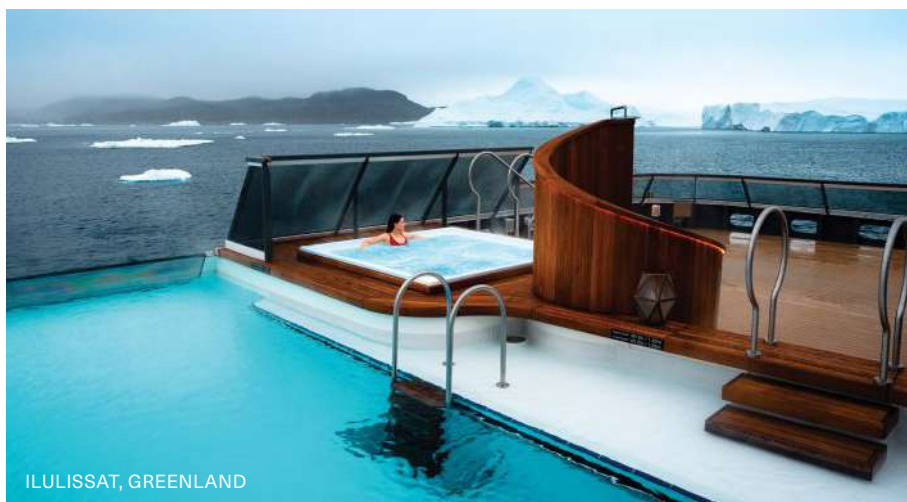
BELLOT STRAIT

This narrow channel between Somerset Island and mainland North America was first charted in 1852 during the search for the Franklin expedition, but it wasn't successfully crossed until 1937. Watch for drifting icebergs and majestic bowhead whales along the way.

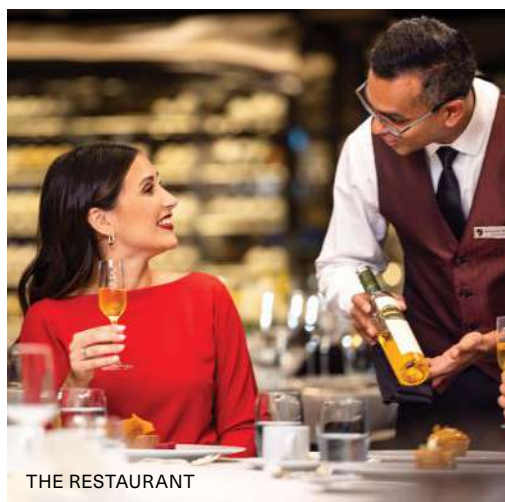


GJOA HAVEN

Roald Amundsen anchored here during his successful navigation of the Northwest Passage, spending two winters conducting geomagnetic observations before pressing west in 1905. The town, named for his ship, remains a stronghold of Inuit culture and traditional handicrafts.

The mass and sheer volume of icebergs from the nearby Jakobshavn Glacier makes Ilulissat one of Greenland's must-see attractions. 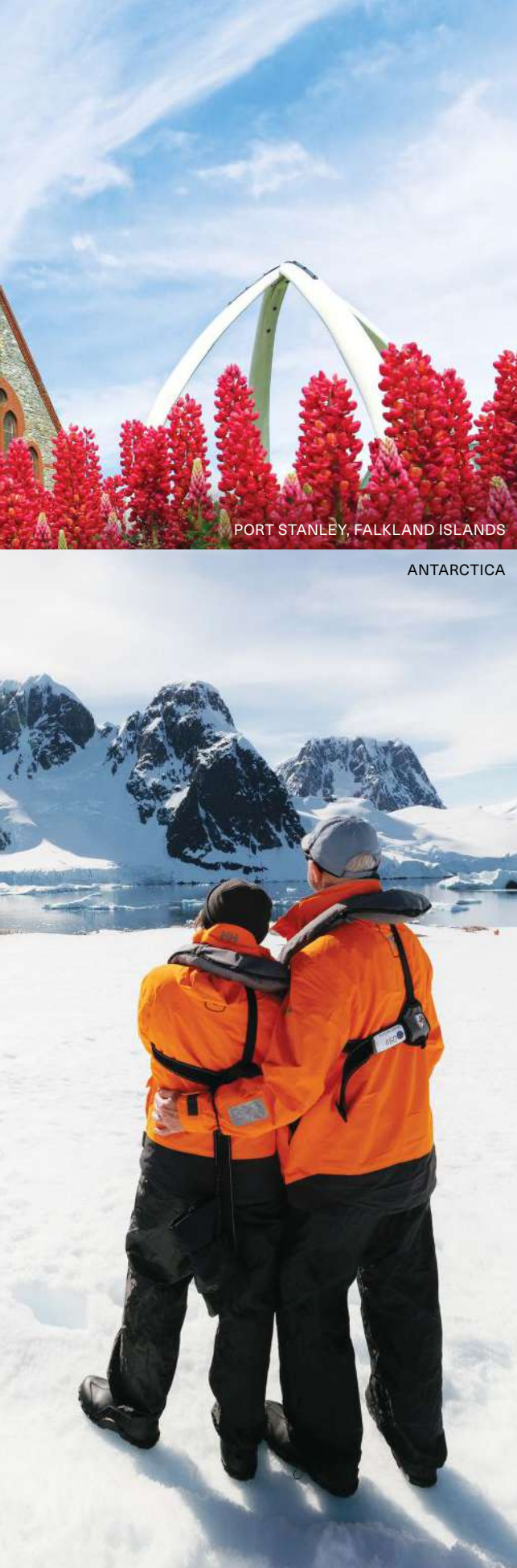

SEASONS OF ANTARCTICA

Antarctica transforms with the season. From the sculpted sea ice of early departures to the wildlife-rich waters of late summer, each expedition reveals a distinct expression of the White Continent — shaped by light, ice, and life at the edge of the world.



EARLY SEASON

(Late October to early December)

Early season brings dramatic sea ice, active penguin courtship and nesting, and the possibility of rare emperor penguin sightings.



MID-SEASON

(Mid-December to early February)

Mid-season offers longer days, ideal conditions for exploration, and the opportunity to see penguin eggs and newly hatched chicks in their nests.



LATE SEASON

(Mid-February to March)

Late season delivers snow-free landing sites, maturing penguin chicks, and peak whale activity — especially humpbacks feeding in rich Antarctic waters.

Half of South Georgia is permanently covered by glaciers. It's inhospitable to man, but the surrounding seas are the most nutrient-rich on earth, making this a mecca for wildlife. You'll find some species here that you probably won't see in Antarctica, like blue whales, elephant seals, and king penguins with their vivid orange throats and ear patches.

EXPEDITION HIGHLIGHT ANTARCTIC WILDLIFE

For such a seemingly desolate landscape, Antarctica is filled with life. Experience unforgettable encounters with wildlife in their natural habitats — spot a pod of killer whales, take in the lively energy of a crowded penguin colony, and feel the thrill of seeing a leopard or Weddell seal from a Zodiac®.

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Spotlight on the Falklands



STEEPLE JASON, WEST FALKLANDS

Distinguished by a pair of pinnacles rising a thousand feet on either side of the island, Steeple Jason is one of the most ecologically abundant places in the Falklands. The white sands here are home to a colony of around 800 gentoo penguins. Observe their playful antics and learn about the endemic flowering plants in the area.

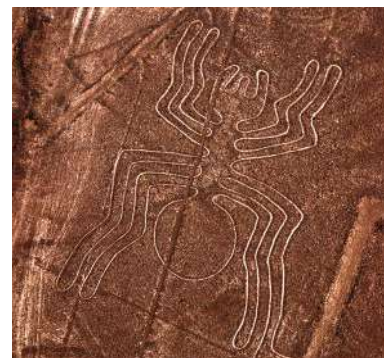

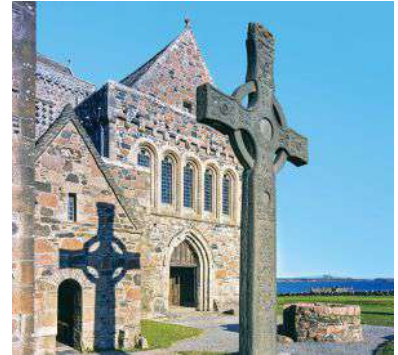

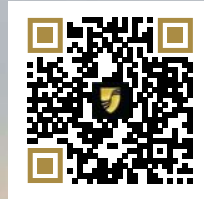
